

Reopening Tribal Gatherings

On Friday, November 6, 2009 the LTBB Emergency Preparedness Team met and discussed lifting the "Suspension of Gatherings" for all Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians activities and gatherings. Although the threat of contracting an influenza virus is still high, the reported cases of influenza (including H1N1) has declined to a level warranting the lifting of the suspension of gatherings implemented by the Executive Branch. Effective immediately all gatherings, activities, luncheons, classes and meetings of the Tribe will resume as planned.
