Sealed Bids for Paradise Lake Boat Washing Station will be received by Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians at the Front Desk, Government Complex, 7500 Odawa Circle, Harbor Springs, Michigan until 2:00 p.m. local time Wednesday, August 22, 2012 at which time all Bids will be publicly read aloud in room 312, Government Complex.
2. The principal items of work consist of the following:

Construction of a boat washing station and related site improvements at the DNR boat access site on Paradise Lake in Emmet County, Michigan to prevent the spread of invasive species into the Great Lakes and connecting waters. Major items of work include 5" water well, pitless adaptor and submersible pump, pressure pumps and spray equipment, 12'x10' service building, miscellaneous plumbing, electrical and site work.
