The benefits of being a WOCTEP student are:

- ▶ Earn college credits: Certificate programs offered in partnership with North Central Michigan College (NCMC)
- ▶ Culturally diverse curriculum: learn how Odawa Culture is relevant in your field of study
- ▶ Early Registration helps to ensure Student Success as you work to complete your Certificate
- ▶ Program Advisor to help guide students through the program
- ▶ Financial Assistance: hourly stipend, childcare and transportation assistance available to participating students, based on income eligibility


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

ANYONE CAN PARTICIPATE IN WOCTEP



WOCTEP is made possible through a US Department of Education NACTEP grant. Federal funds provide 83% (\$386,424) of project costs. Non-federal funds provide 17% (\$77,579) of total project costs. Total costs to operate WOCTEP are \$464,003.

WOCTEP offers assistance to NCMC students enrolled in one or more of our 7 short culturally enriched certificates offered in collaboration with North Central Michigan College.



WOCTEP Financial Assistance

(Eligibility based on 2013 Federal Poverty Guidelines)

- › New Hourly Stipend (Get paid to go to class!) at \$8.25 per hour
- › New Mileage qualification- Simply maintain your certificate program GPA requirements!
- › New Mileage Rate of .565 cents per mile
- › Book Assistance
- › New Childcare Assistance Rates (student must 1st apply with DHS)
- › NCMC Graduation Audit Fee Assistance (\$25)
- › Assistance with medical certification fees (Registered Medical Assistant, Phlebotomy Technician, Certified Nurse Aide)
- › School to Work Kit upon completion
