

LTBB Housing Commission  
Third Quarter Report  
July 2016-October 2016

The LTBB Housing Commission consists of Chairperson Patrick Wemigwase, Secretary Annette VanDeCar and Commissioners Larry Stead and Judith Pierzynowski.

Earlier this year, Stead was re-appointed for a 4-year term ending on March 31, 2020 while VanDeCar was appointed to a 4-year term ending on March 31, 2020.

At the August 5th meeting, VanDeCar became the Secretary with Wemigwase remaining as the Chairperson along with Commissioners Stead and Pierzynowski.

During VanDeCar's interview process for a position on the Housing Commission, Tribal Council had a discussion as to how it needed to review the current Housing Commission statute to see if any changes needed to be made to it.

Following Tribal Council's discussions regarding the statute, Executive Assistant Rebecca Fisher attended our June 24th meeting and asked the commission to review the statute and to send suggestions to the Executive. Commissioners mentioned a couple of things in the statute that concerned them and said they would review the statute further.

The commission held its August 5th meeting at the LTBB Community Building and tentatively plans to hold a meeting at the Murray Road Housing in November. Wemigwase was tasked with inquiring with residents to see who would be willing to host our meeting there. The commission feels this is a good way for the residents at the tribal housing locations to meet the commission, learn about what we do, ask questions and give us any input or suggestions.
