

LTBB Housing Commission  
Second Quarter Report  
April 2017-July 2017

The LTBB Housing Commission consists of Chairperson Patrick Wemigwase, Secretary Annette VanDeCar and Commissioners Larry Stead and Judith Pierzynowski.

The commission did not meet in May 2017, but held regular meetings in April 2017, June 2017 and July 2017.

On May 5, 2017, the Housing Department hosted Spring Clean Up days for both the Wah Wahs Noo Da Ke Village residents and the Mttigwakis Village residents. A large dumpster was onsite at both locations, and household items were accepted at that time.

At the June 14, 2017 meeting, the commission reviewed and discussed the draft Housing Department and Housing Commission Statute, which was posted at the time. Secretary Annette VanDeCar gave a verbal travel report on the Building Michigan Communities Conference she attended and shared materials and information obtained at the conference.

Tribal Council passed the Housing Department and Housing Commission Statute on July 13, 2017, and it is still pending in the Executive Office at this time.

The commission had planned on holding its July 28, 2017 meeting at the Community Building at Wah Wahs Noo Da Ke Village in conjunction with the Housing Department holding a barbecue for housing residents there. However, the Housing Department decided to postpone its barbecue there due to the LTBB Employee Picnic being postponed to that day. The Housing Department rescheduled the barbecue for August 14 in conjunction with the commission's regularly scheduled meeting. The Housing Department will hold a barbecue for Mttigwakis residents on August 4 at 3 p.m.
