Facilities Task Force

In the Waganakising Odawak Constitution, Article VIII, Section C, Paragraph 4, the Powers and Duties of the Tribal Chairperson include the following: "To make recommendations to the Tribal Council on matters of interest of benefit to the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians".

The Executive Branch is authorized to use Executive Directives pursuant to Section XI of the Administrative Procedures Act, WOS 2008-001, to authorize and enable the efficient functioning of tribal projects.

A taskforce is hereby created to perform research and analysis on the future use of our properties and Facilities. The task force is charged with preparing a report supporting recommendations for an Archives and Records storage facility, Youth Services facilities, and other facility needs as they arise.

The members of the task force will be 1) the Geographic Information Systems Director, 2) two representatives from the Planning Department, 3) the Tribal Administrator, 4) a representative from the Executive Office, and 5) a representative from the Accounting Department. Additionally a representative from the Education Department, Youth services and, Archives and Records department is authorized to attend as needed. The taskforce will be chaired by the Tribal Administrator.

This Executive Directive becomes effective January 29, 2009, and will remain in effect until the task force issues its final report or until rescinded by a subsequent Executive action.
