Executive Resolution 08-031306-02
 Indian Reservation Roads Inventory Additions

WHEREAS the Waganakising Odawak, known as the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians, is a nation of citizens with inherent sovereignty and right to self-governance; and,

WHEREAS the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians ("LTBB" or "Tribe") is a Federally recognized Indian Tribe reaffirmed by the United States Congress on September 21, 1994 in Public Law 103-324, as amended, which exercises sovereign governmental authority over the people, land, and water within its jurisdiction and administers a wide range of governmental programs; and,

WHEREAS the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians Tribal Constitution adopted on February 1, 2005, creates the Executive Branch of the Tribal Government and the Tribal Chairman is the elected official who exercises executive authority under this Constitution; and,

WHEREAS the Executive Branch is hereby authorized to use Executive Resolutions, Directives and other such instruments deemed necessary Section IX Tribal Administrative Procedures Act 11-20-05; and,

WHEREAS the Bureau of Indian Affairs, Indian Reservation Roads Program has provided the Tribe with an opportunity to update the Tribes Indian Reservation Roads Inventory; and,

WHEREAS the Tribe wishes to ensure the future of the local transportation for the benefit of its members; and,

WHEREAS there are funds available through the Bureau of Indian Affairs for a program of services, which will meet those needs as identified in the Long- Range Plan and by the addition of roads to the inventory.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians Executive Office approves the updated and additional roads to the Indian Reservation Roads Inventory.

CERTIFICATION

As Tribal Chairman, I certify that this Executive Resolution is in full force as of March 13, 2006, and will remain so until replaced by a subsequent Executive Resolution.
