WHEREAS the Waganakising Odawak Nation, known as the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians, and its citizens are vested with inherent sovereignty and right to self-governance;

WHEREAS the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians ("LTBB" or "Tribe") is a federally recognized Indian Tribe under Public Law 103-324, and is a party to numerous Treaties with the United States the most recent of which being the Treaty of Washington of March 28, 1836 (7 Stat. 491) and the Treaty of Detroit of 1855 (11 Stat. 621);

WHEREAS the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians Tribal Council is the elected legislative body of the Tribe;

WHEREAS the disease of diabetes continues to be a serious and growing problem for Native American communities throughout North America;

WHEREAS diabetes is a recognized problem within the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians;

WHEREAS promotion of the health and welfare of the tribal community is a priority of the Little Traverse Bay Bands;

WHEREAS the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services, Indians Health Service, Special Diabetes Program for Indians has announced the availability of continuation funding for Diabetes Prevention and Healthy Heart Initiatives to provide services for the prevention and treatment of diabetes and cardiovascular disease.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council of the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians authorizes and supports this request for two years of continuation funding for the LTBB SDPI Healthy Heart Program.
