Approval of the Memorandum of Understanding
Between
Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians Law Enforcement Department
and
Charlevoix-Cheboygan-Emmet Central Dispatch Authority

- WHEREAS:** the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians ("LTBB" or "Tribe") is a Federally recognized Indian Tribe reaffirmed by the United States Congress on September 21, 1994 in Public Law 103-324, as amended, which exercises sovereign governmental authority over the people, land, and water within its jurisdiction and administers a wide range of governmental programs;
- WHEREAS:** the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians Tribal Council is the elected governing body of the Tribe;
- WHEREAS:** the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians Law Enforcement Department and the Charlevoix-Cheboygan-Emmet (CCE) Central Dispatch Authority are separate and autonomous regional public entities in the State of Michigan;
- WHEREAS:** the LTBB Law Enforcement Department and the CCE Central Dispatch Authority provide a form of public safety in the same geographic area and both entities recognize the need to work collaboratively on certain projects that may mutually benefit each other and the citizens they serve;
- WHEREAS:** the LTBB Law Enforcement Department and the CCE Central Dispatch Authority both recognize that the regional sharing of resources will provide a higher level of interoperability and preparedness, eliminate possible duplication of key equipment and services, and enhance the ability of participating law enforcement agencies sharing common border areas and infrastructure to work collaboratively to ensure the highest possible level of services; and
- WHEREAS:** the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians desires to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding with the Charlevoix-Cheboygan-Emmet Central Dispatch Authority to collaborate on communication and data sharing of Public Safety Computer Aided Dispatch, Records and Jail Management, and Radio Communications to enhance public safety for Tribal Citizens and Law Enforcement Agencies.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council of the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians authorizes and approves the Memorandum of Understanding between the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians and the Charlevoix-Cheboygan-Emmet (CCE) Central Dispatch Authority to support collaborative activities.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Council of the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians authorizes the LTBB Tribal Chairperson, Tribal Vice Chairperson, or Tribal Administrator, or another designee from the Tribal Chairperson to execute any documents needed for LTBB's participation in the Memorandum of Understanding.
