7 SECTION I. PURPOSE

8
9 This Statute is hereby enacted to establish Gijigowi--Bib Skaa Bii Me (meaning Victor
10 Simon Kishigo--Coming Back To) an the eEducational and cCultural lLearning Department to
11 promote education and cultural learning and revitalize Anishinaabemowin. This Statute is in
12 honor of Gijigowi, Victor Simon Kishigo, for his dedication and work to revitalize Anishinaabe
13 Culture and Anishinaabemowin. This Statute repeals "Gijigowi Anishinaabemowin Language
14 Department" WOS 2009-010.

17 SECTION II. DEFINITIONS

- 19 A. "Anishinaabemowin" means the language spoken by the Odawa people.
- 20
- 21 B. "Cultural" means aspects of the Odawa history, spirituality, traditions, arts and crafts,
- 22 values and mannerisms.

- 24 C. "Cultural Proficiency" means the knowledge, skills, and attitudes/beliefs that enable a
- 25 person to work well with, respond effectively to, and be supportive of the Odawa Citizens.

- 27 D. "Department" means ~~Education and Cultural Learning~~ Gijigowi--Bib Skaa Bii Me
- 28 Department.

- 30 E. "Tribe" means the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians.

1 A. Pursuant to Article VII (D) (22) of the Tribal Constitution the Tribal Council shall have
2 the power to: “Approve the creation or dissolution of Executive divisions or departments to
3 promote and protect the peace, health, safety, education, and general welfare, including but not
4 limited to cultural and natural resources, of the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians and
5 its members”.

6
7 B. The Tribal Council hereby approves the creation of the Gijigowi--Bib Skaa Bii Me
8 ~~Education and Cultural Learning~~Gijigowi--Bib Skaa Bii Me Department within the Executive
9 Branch of government.

12 **SECTION IV. AUTHORITY AND DUTIES**

13
14 A. The Department shall have the following duties:

- 15
16 1. Promote, design and implement ~~c~~Cultural training programs for each facet of our
17 tribal community and tribal government.
18
19 2. Strive to improve and enhance the understanding of tribal culture within our
20 community and in the greater community.
21
22 3. Collaborate with other LTBB departments to infuse culture and spirituality into
23 their programs and activities.
24
25 4. Assist with annual community events that incorporate Odawa traditions
26 and culture.
27
28 5. Provide services and programs that increase accessibility to two kinds of
29 "traditional" education in tandem: formal, mainstream schooling and culturally-based,
30 spiritual teachings.
31
32 6. Administer education-based programs, grants and projects that assist our
33 people reach their personal, educational goals with an awareness of the unique needs of
34 our tribal citizens.

12 ~~10.9.~~ Collect, preserve and manage any and all information about the Odawa people,
13 both historical and contemporary, utilizing the most current methods of archival
14 preservation and digitization in order to create a seamless process for internal creation of
15 educational materials, programs, classes and resources.

17 ~~11.10.~~ Serve as a clearing house and storage facility for all government documents and
18 products created through government processes and functions.

20 ~~12.11.~~ Continue to pursue the return of human remains and artifacts as one more vital
21 aspect of learning from our past and revitalizing our culture and spirituality by ensuring
22 respectful and effective methods of sharing with our contemporary community.

24 ~~13.12.~~ Administer all BIA education-related programs and funding received by the
25 Tribe.

26
27 ~~14.13.~~ Administer all funds and grants to the Tribe related to Anishinaabemowin,
28 ~~culture, spirituality, history and education.~~

30 ~~15.14.~~ Develop ~~and provide~~ Anishinaabemowin resources, including curriculum, training
31 aids, video and audio products.

10 | SECTION V. STAFFING

12 | **A.** The Department shall begin operations with current staff of the Language, Education and
13 | Archives and Records Departments as appropriate and Executive may restructure as necessary.

15 | **B.** All research, academic, and work products produced by the Department shall belong to
16 | the Tribe and be considered public documents.

18 | **C.** Credits may be given for program and/or individual contributions to materials produced
19 | by the Department.

21 | **D.** Copies may be used in educational promotion of Anishinaabemowin; all copies shall
22 | include all original credits.

24 | **E.** Copy for profit shall be prohibited.

26 | **F.** Only persons who possess cultural proficiency shall be eligible for hire in this
27 | Department with the exception of hiring persons that provide technical expertise outside of the
28 | Odawa Cultural or ~~Anishinaabemowin~~ Anishinaabemowin.

31 | SECTION VI. REGULATIONS REQUIRED

33 | Any regulations shall be developed by the Executive Branch and presented to Tribal
34 | Council for approval in accordance with the Administrative Procedures Act.

SECTION VII. APPROPRIATIONS AUTHORIZED

Any current appropriations for the Language, Education and Archives and Records Departments, as appropriate, shall be used to implement this Statute and the Executive shall present Tribal Council with future annual budgets necessary to implement this Statute.

SECTION VIII. SEVERABILITY

If any section, subsection, paragraph, sentence, phrase or portion of this Statute is, for any reason, held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions thereof.

SECTION IX. EFFECTIVE DATE

Effective upon signature of the Executive or 30 days from Tribal Council approval which ever comes first or if the Executive vetoes the legislation, then upon Tribal Council override of the veto.
