RESOLUTION 08049602

APPROVAL OF RESTORATION PLAN

WHEREAS the Secretary of the Interior is generally authorized to accept land into trust for the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians under the Indian Reorganization Act, 25 U.S.C. § 465, and is explicitly required to accept land into trust for the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians in Emmet and Charlevoix Counties, Michigan, by the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians and the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians Act, 25 U.S.C §1300k-4(a). In addition, 25 U.S.C. §1300k-4(c) also provides that the “Secretary may accept . . .” lands which are within the Tribe’s service area, which is defined at §1300k-2(b) as the area within a 70 mile radius of the Tribe’s reservation as defined in the Treaty of July 31, 1855.

WHEREAS the Tribe prepared the Land Base Restoration Plan attached to this Resolution to meet its needs for housing, administration, economic development, hunting, gathering, ceremonials, buffer sites, and exercise of Treaty rights.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians adopts the attached Land Base Restoration Plan as presented at this meeting of the Tribal Council of August 4, 1996.

Certification

As Tribal Chairman and Tribal Secretary, the undersigned certify that this Resolution was duly adopted by the Tribal Council of the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians at a regular meeting of the Tribal Council held on August 4, 1996 at which a quorum was present, by a vote of 7 in favor, 0 opposed and 0 abstentions as recorded by this roll call.
