Whereas, the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians of Michigan is a federally recognized tribe, as reaffirmed under P.L. 103-324, enacted September 21, 1994; **and**

Whereas, the Tribe wishes to ensure the future of the local transportation system for the benefit of its members; **and**

Whereas, the Tribal Council has determined that there is a need for road improvements within the Reservation area; **and**

Whereas; there are funds available through the Bureau of Indian Affairs for a program of services which will meet those needs as identified annually by the Tribal Council; **and**

Whereas, the Bureau of Indian Affairs, Indian Reservation Roads Program has provided the Tribe with an opportunity to indicate its Transportation Project Priorities for the period 1999 to 2003;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians Tribal Council approves the priorities and projects as indicated in the FY 1999 Tribal Transportation Improvement Program.
