Approval of FY 2002 Tribal Indian Reservation Roads Inventory

WHEREAS the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians ("LTBB") is a federally recognized Tribe as reaffirmed under Public Law 103-324, enacted September 21, 1994;

WHEREAS LTBB desires to ensure the future of the local transportation system for the benefit and safety of its members and the general public;

WHEREAS the Tribal Council has determined that there is a need for transportation planning activities within the Reservation area;

WHEREAS there are funds available through the Bureau of Indian Affairs for a program of services which will meet those needs as identified annually by the Tribal Council;

WHEREAS the Bureau of Indian Affairs, Indian Reservation Roads Program has provided LTBB with the opportunity to agree as to the content and extent of LTBB's Indian Reservation Roads Inventory;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians Tribal Council approves the road segments as indicated in the FY 2002 Tribal Indian Reservation Roads Inventory.
