Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians

(A Happy Odawa Family Kitchen)

- WHEREAS** the Waganakising Odawak Nation, known as the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians, and its citizens are vested with inherent sovereignty and right to self-governance;
- WHEREAS** the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians (“LTBB” or “Tribe”) is a federally recognized Indian Tribe under Public Law 103-324, and is a party to numerous Treaties with the United States the most recent of which being the Treaty of Washington of March 28, 1836 (7 Stat. 491) and the Treaty of Detroit of 1855 (11 Stat. 621);
- WHEREAS** the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians Tribal Council is the elected legislative body of the Tribe;
- WHEREAS** promotion of the health and welfare of the tribal community is a priority of the Little Traverse Bay Bands;
- WHEREAS** heart disease, hypertension, cancer and diabetes continue to be health concerns within the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians;
- WHEREAS** the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians is committed to improving health behaviors and reducing diet-related disease among its citizens;
- WHEREAS** the Northern Michigan Hospital has been awarded funding from the Blue Cross Blue Shield of Michigan Foundation for implementation of a collaborative project with LTBB that focuses on the principles of nutrition and exercise to reduce the risk of diet-related disease such as heart disease, hypertension, cancer and diabetes.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council of the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians authorizes the receipt of funds from the Northern Michigan Regional Hospital for program funding to implement the project, “Chi-nendimok Odawak Ezhi-ngodwewaangizwad Jiibaakwegamgoong,” or “A Happy Odawa Family Kitchen.”
