

WAGANAKISING ODAWAK STATUTE 1998002
AMENDMENT TO LITTLE TRAVERSE BAY BANDS OF ODAWA INDIANS
COMMERCIAL AND SUBSISTENCE FISHING RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR
THE TREATY CEDED WATERS OF LAKES SUPERIOR, HURON AND MICHIGAN

The Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians Commercial and Subsistence Fishing Rules and Regulations For the Treaty Ceded Waters of Lakes Superior, Huron and Michigan (Waganakising Odawak Statute 1997016) is amended to open the Lake Michigan waters contained in Grids 517, 518, 519, 414, and 415 and all of the waters in 314 to LTBB commercial and subsistence fishing.
