

Rules of Criminal Procedure Amendment  
1.401 (A)



LTBB Tribal Court Judiciary has amended the Rules of Criminal Procedure 1.401 (A).  
The language of the rule prior to amendment was as follows:

“Defendants have the right to a speedy trial. A trial shall be held within forty-five (45) days of arraignment. A defendant has the right to waive his or her right to a speedy trial.”

The new amended and adopted Rule 1.401 (A) is as follows:

“Defendants have the right to a speedy trial. A trial shall be held within **ninety (90) days** of arraignment. A defendant has the right to waive his or her right to a speedy trial.”

**This amendment was adopted by a unanimous Judiciary on May 19, 2010.**
