**TRIBAL MOTION**

Request for Funding from the Seventh Generation Fund for Indian Development,  
Environmental Health and Justice Program,  
Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians  
Pharmaceutical and Over-the-Counter Drug Drop Off Project

- WHEREAS** the Waganakising Odawak Nation, known as the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians, and its citizens are vested with inherent sovereignty and right to self-governance;
- WHEREAS** the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians (“LTBB” or “Tribe”) is a federally recognized Indian Tribe under Public Law 103-324, and is a party to numerous Treaties with the United States the most recent of which being the Treaty of Washington of March 28, 1836 (7 Stat. 491) and the Treaty of Detroit of 1855 (11 Stat. 621);
- WHEREAS** the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians Tribal Council is the elected legislative body of the Tribe;
- WHEREAS** the Tribe’s treaty delineated reservation area encompasses approximately 336 square miles in Northwestern-Lower Michigan with Lake Michigan as the western boundary of the reservation area;
- WHEREAS** the LTBB relies on environmental protection for the health of Tribal citizens and for cultural perpetuation;
- WHEREAS** the Tribe operates an Environmental Services Department with a mission to ensure the protection of our natural resources including the restoration and maintenance of the chemical, physical, and biological integrity of the Great Lakes Ecosystem;
- WHEREAS** the appropriate and safe disposal of unwanted electronics and unused medicines is not readily available for the Tribal community and the community-at-large;
- WHEREAS:** the Seventh Generation Fund for Indian Development has announced funding availability for awards that would assist Indian communities in implementing programs for Environmental Health and Justice.

**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the Tribal Council of the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians authorizes and supports this request for funding from the Seventh Generation Fund for Indian Development, Environmental Health and Justice Program for a Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians Pharmaceutical and Over-the-Counter Drug Drop off Project.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the LTBB Tribal Chairman, Tribal Vice Chairman, Tribal Administrator, or another designee from the Tribal Chairman is authorized to execute any documents necessary to apply for, receive, and administer funds under the grant.
