Murray Road Development Site Plan as drafted by Coleman Engineering Company, and on
recommendations by Planning Director Bryan Gillett, the Land and Reservation Committee
recommends that Tribal Council approve the Murray Road Site Plan as presented on Page 5 of
the aforementioned Murray Road Development document.
