Steps

1. Presentation of prompting statement
2. Silent writing of ideas
3. Round Robin recording of ideas
4. Preliminary choices
5. Reveal each table's choices
6. Final vote
7. Vote/Tabulation of Results

Steps

1. Presentation of prompting statement
 - “What type or categories of land should the tribe acquire that would most benefit the LTBB?”

Steps

2. Silent writing of ideas

- Individual thinking and writing (5-10min) on paper pads – brainstorming, in individual bullet points.
- At every table:
 - 1 large flip chart sheet
 - 1 marker, 8 golf pencils
 - Individual writing paper pads

Steps

3. Round Robin recording of ideas
 - Each table selects a Recorder
 - Recorder transcribes ideas onto chart (one point from each individual until entire list complete)
 - No evaluation of ideas at this time
 - New ideas presented in turn

Steps

4. Preliminary Choices

- Each table member silently looks at compiled overall list and chooses 3-5 best ideas.
- In turn, each member communicates top 3-5 ideas to Recorder (tabulates with hash-marks).
- From top choices (up to 15), the Recorder rewrites them on a new piece of flip chart paper.

Steps

5. Reveal each table's choices
 - Facilitators will collect new list from each table and post on the wall.
 - 15 minutes for room to review each list

Steps

6. Final Vote

- Each participant will receive 5 stickers (votes).
- Participants will then vote for their top choice(s).

7. Vote/Tabulation of Results
