

**LITTLE TRAVERSE BAY BANDS OF ODAWA INDIANS  
ELDER'S SNOWPLOWING PROGRAM**

**1. POLICY**

**A. Statement of purpose**

The purpose of this policy is to give guidance in providing elders snowplowing services, who live alone or have a housemate with verifiable limitations prohibiting them from removing or plowing snow from around their own home and meet the LTBB Housing income guidelines.

**B. Location**

This program will be managed in the Elder's program.

**C. Funding**

This policy is effective for snowplowing funding in the Elder's Program.

**D. Program Assistance**

The Elder's Snowplowing program will provide snowplowing services to Tribal Elder's within Emmett, Charlevoix, and Cheboygan Counties.

**E. Eligibility Criteria**

Eligibility will be determined by the program coordinator. In order to receive snowplowing services, the following criteria must be met:

1. Applicant shall be a Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians Tribal Elder (55 years of age or older).
2. Applicant must complete an application with the LTBB Elders program.
3. Applicant must be eligible according to the LTBB Housing income guidelines.
4. Applicant must live alone or have a housemate or spouse who has a verifiable health limitation preventing them from removing or plowing snow around their own house.

**F. Disputes**

Disputes regarding determinations of eligibility may be taken to the Tribal Administrator for review and / or redetermination.
