SUBMISSION OF UNITED WAY APPLICATION FOR FUNDING

WHEREAS the promotion of the education of all tribal members is central to the mission of the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians;

WHEREAS many Native American youth in Emmet and Charlevoix counties experience a lack of academic success and improvement in this area would contribute to the good of the community at large;

WHEREAS because the Tribe's administrative capabilities and cultural perspective, it is uniquely situated to help Native Americans achieve academic success,

WHEREAS many Native American students lack funds for basic educational needs, such as books, lab fees, transportation, tutoring and extra-curricular activities and funds from the CharEm United Way would help the Tribe provide these needs;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians submits an application to the CharEm United Way for Funding for Emergency Educational Assistance. The Tribal Chairman is authorized to sign the application and any other documents required for this submission.
