SUPPORT FOR INTER-TRIBAL COUNCIL CIRCLE OF CARE PROPOSAL

WHEREAS the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians, a Federally recognized Indian tribe, is a member of the Inter-Tribal Council of Michigan, Inc., an inter-tribal entity that promotes coordination of services, funding and programs for the ten Federally recognized member tribes in Michigan;

WHEREAS the physical and mental well-being of its children are of great importance to the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians;

WHEREAS the Inter-Tribal Council of Michigan is in the process of developing a "Circle of Care" proposal on behalf of its member tribes for submission to the Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration Center for Mental Health Services (SAMHSA) to promote culturally appropriate mental health services and programs for tribal children;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians supports the efforts of the Inter-Tribal Council to develop a "Circle of Care" proposal for future submission to the SAMHSA.
