Request for Funding from the Human Services Coordinating Body of
Charlevoix and Emmet County,
Strong Families/Safe Children Mini-grant - Year 2004

WHEREAS: the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians (“LTBB” or “Tribe”) is a Federally recognized Indian Tribe reaffirmed by the United States Congress on September 21, 1994 in Public Law 103-324, as amended, which exercises sovereign governmental authority over the people, land, and water within its jurisdiction and administers a wide range of governmental programs;

WHEREAS: the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians Tribal Council is the elected governing body of the Tribe;

WHEREAS: the LTBB governmental services includes the Human Services Department that is committed to the support and preservation of all aspects of family life, and to wrapping services around the Anishinaabek communities;

WHEREAS: the Human Services Coordinating Body of Charlevoix and Emmet County has announced the availability of funding to support families in the two county area.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council of the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians authorizes and supports this request for funding from the Human Services Coordinating Body of Charlevoix and Emmet County for a LTBB Strong Families/Safe Children mini-grant.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Tribal Chairman Frank Ettawageshik or his designee is authorized to execute any documents necessary to apply for, receive, and administer funds under the grant.
