

WAGANAKISING ODAWAK STATUTE 1995002

SECTION 5. Eligibility Criteria for Membership

The membership of the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians shall consist of all persons born prior to May 2, 1996, who are one-fourth (1/4) or more Indian blood quantum, of which at least one-eighth (1/8) of the total blood quantum is traceable to persons identified in Section 5(a-c), and have submitted application on or before May 2, 1996, provided such persons are not currently enrolled in any other Federally recognized Indian Tribe or Band:

(a) All persons whose name appears on the Durant Roll of 1908, as approved by the Secretary of the Interior on February 18, 1910; and

(b) All direct lineal descendants of persons listed on the 1870 Annuity payrolls of Ottawa & Chippewa Indians of Michigan listed under the following chiefs:

Nawwemaishcotay/Cross Village, Shawwawdayse/Charlevoix, Shawwawgwawnaybe/Bay Shore, Louis Micksawbay/Charlevoix Awmegwawbay/Petoskey, Nawogemaw/Goodhart-Middle Village, Simon Keywawekizhick/Harbor Springs, Joseph Waybwaydum/Burt Lake, Daniel Nesawwawquot/Harbor Springs, Payzhickwaywedong/BeaverIsland, Nawoquaygawbose/Manistique, Kawgegaypenayse/North Shore; or

(c) All persons of Michigan Odawa/Ottawa & Chippewa descent who resided in the areas in Section 5(b) of this Ordinance as amended on 02/19/95 at the time of the 1908 Durant Roll as approved by the Secretary of the Interior on February 18, 1910. This will be determined by Durant's Roll and corresponding fieldnote's which indicate residency and can also be referenced in the 1860-1920 Federal Populations Enumerations (i.e. Census Records).

SECTION 14.

Annual Report Requirement. All members of the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians shall be required to report to the Tribal Enrollment Office Staff on an annual basis in order to be entitled to any monetary benefits that may accrue to members.

1. Such reports shall be addressed to the Tribal Office and contain the following information:
 - a. Legal name of member;
 - b. Membership number; and
 - c. Current address.
2. Such reports shall be submitted annually on or before August 31st of each year.
3. Within 90 days after August 31st of each year the Tribal Enrollment Officer shall submit a report to the Tribal Council, which shall contain:
 - a. The total number of reporting members;
 - b. A complete updated role;
 - c. The date filed; and
 - d. A list of delinquent members who have failed to provide annual report information.
4. In the event that a member fails to comply with the annual reporting requirement their monetary benefits will be denied until such time as they submit their annual report.
