Request for Funding from the Office of Justice Programs,

Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians
Fiscal Year 2012 Adult Drug Court Enhancement Grant

WHEREAS the Waganakising Odawak Nation, known as the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians, and its citizens are vested with inherent sovereignty and right to self-governance;

WHEREAS the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians is a federally recognized Indian Tribe under Public Law 103-324, and is a party to numerous Treaties with the United States the most recent of which being the Treaty of Washington of March 28, 1836 (7 Stat. 491) and the Treaty of Detroit of 1855 (11 Stat. 621);

WHEREAS the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians Tribal Council is the elected legislative body of the Tribe;

WHEREAS the LTBB Tribal Court has been established to secure the enjoyment of community and personal rights guaranteed by Tribal law, federal law, and the Tribal Constitution through a fair, just and impartial judiciary system;

WHEREAS LTBB is committed to providing services for adults who desire to break the cycle of substance abuse by successful rehabilitation through early, continuous, and intense judicially supervised treatment, mandatory periodic drug testing, and community supervision;

WHEREAS the Tribal Court has established an Adult Drug Court and desires to enhance the services provided to current and future clients;

WHEREAS the United States Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs, Bureau of Justice Assistance, has announced the availability of funding under the Drug Court Discretionary Grant Program for FY 2012 Adult Drug Court Enhancement Grants.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council of the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians authorizes and supports this request for funding from the U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs, Bureau of Justice Assistance, Adult Drug Court

Discretionary Grant Program, for a 3-year Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians Waabshki-Miigwan Adult Drug Court Enhancement grant.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians in requesting this funding agrees to provide 25 percent of the total budget as match and this match will be satisfied with a combination of in-kind services and cash from the Tribal Court budget.

FINALLY BE IT RESOLVED that Tribal Chairman Tribal Chairman, Vice Chairman Vice-Chair, or Tribal Administrator, or another designee from the Tribal Chairman is authorized to execute any documents necessary to apply for, receive, and administer funds under the grant.
