Culturally-Integrated Physical Activities

- WHEREAS** the Waganakising Odawak, known in English as Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians is a nation of citizens with inherent sovereignty and right to self-governance;
- WHEREAS** the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians (“LTBB”) is a federally recognized Indian Tribe under Public Law 103-324, and is a party to numerous Treaties with the United States the most recent of which being the Treaty of Washington of March 28, 1836 (7 Stat. 491) and the Treaty of Detroit of 1855 (11 Stat. 621);
- WHEREAS** the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians Tribal Council is the elected legislative body of the Tribe;
- WHEREAS** the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians recognizes the importance of reaching out to the next seven generations by holding to cultural values of Wisdom, Love, Respect, Bravery, Honesty, Humility and Truth.
- WHEREAS** the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians operates a Youth Services program with a mission that all youth will be educated spiritually, mentally, physically and emotionally to create a strong a safe community.
- WHEREAS** the Youth Services Program encourages and promotes cultural integration into physical activities and wellness.
- WHEREAS** the N7 Fund has announced funding available to create positive experiences in sport and physical activity for Native American youth.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council of the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians authorizes and supports this grant application to the N7 Fund to provide culturally-integrated physical activities and experiences to community youth.

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the LTBB Tribal Chair, Vice Chair, Tribal Administrator, or another designee from the Tribal Chair is authorized to execute any documents necessary to apply for, receive, and administer funds under the grant.
