Well & Septic Systems Contract BE-15-J53 Modification #02

- WHEREAS** the Waganakising Odawak Nation, known as the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians, and its citizens are vested with inherent sovereignty and right to self-governance;
- WHEREAS** the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians ("LTBB" or "Tribe") is a federally recognized Indian Tribe under Public Law 103-324, and is a party to numerous Treaties with the United States the most recent of which being the Treaty of Washington of March 28, 1836 (7 Stat. 491) and the Treaty of Detroit of 1855 (11 Stat. 621);
- WHEREAS** the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians Tribal Council is the elected legislative body of the Tribe;
- WHEREAS** the tribe and its members are eligible for all services and benefits by the Federal Government to Indians;
- WHEREAS** the Indian Health Service provides sanitation facilities to the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians on a yearly basis by contracting with the tribe for the installation of sanitation facilities such as wells, septic mound systems, community sewer connection, community water connection, etc;
- WHEREAS** the tribe does not have the financial means or the equipment to install these facilities;
- WHEREAS** the Contract Number BE-15-J5 has been modified by the Indian Health Services for a funding increase of \$80,000.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council of the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians supports and authorizes the acceptance of an increase in funds in the amount of \$80,000 from the Indian Health Services for the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians contract number BE-15-J53.

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the LTBB Tribal Chairperson, Vice Chairperson, Tribal Administrator, or another designee from the Tribal Chairperson is authorized to execute any documents necessary to apply for, receive, and administer funds under the grant.
