Resolution 09109502

To support the Readmond/Friendship Park Management Committee in managing the operation of the Readmond/Friendship Park (RFP) in such manner as to protect the historical and archaeological resources, the habitat of protected flora and fauna, to safeguard the dunes against degradation, and to protect the public's right of access to the beach.

Whereas the Waganakising Odawak (Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians) are a sovereign people residing in the area of creation now known as the State of Michigan, United States of America, **AND**

Whereas the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians Tribal Council endeavors to provide for the perpetuation of our way of life and the welfare and prosperity of our people, to preserve the right of self government, to protect our property and resources, **AND**

Whereas the government-to-government relationship between the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians and the United States was reaffirmed on September 21, 1994, by the signing of Public Law 103-324, **AND**

Whereas representatives of Readmond Township, Friendship Township, and the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians have developed the structure for a Readmond/Friendship Park Management Committee, **AND**

Whereas such a committee is required by the Michigan Natural Resources Trust Fund, and is subject to the approval of the DNR, **AND**

Now therefore be it resolved that the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians Tribal Council in open meeting on September 10, 1995

authorizes the Tribal Chairman, Frank Ettawageshik to make the appropriate arrangements and sign the resolution supporting the Readmond/Friendship Park Management Committee in their execution of stated duties.

CERTIFICATE OF ADOPTION

This resolution was considered and adopted by the Tribal Council of the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians at a meeting held on September 10, 1995, at which a quorum was present, by a vote of 5 in favor, 0 opposed and 0 abstentions.
