

Community Health Availability

For the week of March 23rd through the 27th, we will be available for the following services:

Employees are screened for wellness at the start of each day. If anyone has any upper respiratory illness symptoms or fever, they are sent home. This will limit our availability but protects the health of our community.

Patient Transports: urgent care visits only! You will receive a phone call from your transporter when they are at your location, and you will be screened prior to entering the vehicle. No one is coming to your front door, so keep a watch out for them. Vehicles are being disinfected after each transport.

Home Visits: as per our usual. We will not enter your home unless we are well.

Medication Drop-offs: we will deliver your prescriptions for you if you are not able to get to the tribal pharmacy to pick them up yourself. We will not enter your house; someone must be able to meet us outside.

Foot Clinic: all regular visits are being postponed. If you have a problem with your foot that needs urgent attention, you are directed to contact the Tribal Clinic to be triaged. You may be referred out.

Maternal Child Health: Carol Sodman-Morris, the Maternal-Child Health Nurse, will be in the office Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays. If you are in need of MCH services, please contact her at 242-1614 to make arrangements. If you call on Tuesday or Thursday, you may not be able to receive assistance.

Understand that at this time, no clients are entering the Health Park unless they are being seen for urgent services. We are here, however, for phone consultation if you have questions, issues or concerns.
