WHEREAS the Waganakising Odawak, known in English as Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians is a nation of citizens with inherent sovereignty and right to self-governance and;

WHEREAS the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians ("LTBB") is a federally recognized Indian Tribe under Public Law 103-324, and is a party to numerous Treaties with the United States the most recent of which being the Treaty of Washington of March 28, 1836 (7 Stat. 491) and the Treaty of Detroit of 1855 (11 Stat. 621);

WHEREAS the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians Tribal Council is the elected legislative body of the Tribe;

WHEREAS the Tribe places a high priority on the well-being of the LTBB Tribal Elders;

WHEREAS the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services, Administration for Community Living has announced funding availability under the PPHF-2014- Evidence-Based Falls Prevention Programs Financed Solely by 2014 Prevention and Public Health Funds.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council of the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians authorizes and supports this request for funding from the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services, Administration for Community Living, to reduce and prevent Elder Falls in our Tribal community through PPHF- 2014- Evidence-Based Falls Prevention Programs Financed Solely by 2014 Prevention and Public Health Funds.

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the LTBB Tribal Chair, Vice Chair, Tribal Administrator, or another designee from the Tribal Chair is authorized to execute any documents necessary to apply for, receive, and administer funds under the grant.
