Request for funding from the Bureau of Indian Affairs  
Fire Management / Fuel Reduction Funds Project

- WHEREAS** the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians (“LTBB”) is a federally recognized Indian Tribe reaffirmed by the United States Congress on September 21<sup>st</sup>, 1994 in Public Law 103-324, as amended which exercises sovereign governmental authority over the people, land and water within its jurisdiction and administers a wide range of governmental programs
- WHEREAS** the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians Tribal Council is the elected Legislative body of the Tribe;
- WHEREAS** the Tribe has established a Natural Resources Department (NRD) and a Natural Resource Commission (NRC) whose purpose is to provide oversight and regulation of utilization of natural resources within the LTBB’s jurisdiction and to provide community input in development and fulfillment of project objectives at regularly scheduled meetings of the Natural Resource Commission;
- WHEREAS** the Natural Resource Department mission statement is to “*wisely utilize our natural resources in order to promote, honor, and respect our traditional, spiritual and physical relationship with land and waters. We will implement management strategies that protect our resources on, above, below and within the land and waters for the future benefit of our Tribe;*”
- WHEREAS** the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians Natural Resources Department has developed a Strategic Plan that provides direction and guidance for the Department and is updated annually;
- WHEREAS** the Strategic Plan, NRD Inland Fish and Wildlife 2009 Report Goal V. is to monitor, assess, develop, and implement strategies for managing and /or eradicating Invasive species;
- WHEREAS** the Bureau of Indian Affairs has notified LTBB of funds available to assist the tribe in conducting fire management activities, including fuel reduction and fire suppression.

**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Tribal Council of the Little Traverse Bay

Bands of Odawa Indians authorizes and supports this request for funding from the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Indian Affairs, Fire Management Program for an LTBB FY 2015 Fire Management / Fuel Reduction Funds Project.

**FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the LTBB Tribal Chair, Vice Chair, Tribal Administrator, or another designee from the Tribal Chair is authorized to execute any documents necessary to apply for, receive, and administer funds under the grant.
