Designation of Ziibimijwang Assets

WHEREAS the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians is a federally recognized Indian Tribe reaffirmed by the United States Congress on September 21, 1994 in Public Law 103-324, as amended, which exercises sovereign governmental authority over the people, land, and water within its jurisdiction;

WHEREAS the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians ("LTBB" or "Tribe") is a federally recognized Indian Tribe under Public Law 103-324, and is a party to numerous Treaties with the United States the most recent of which being the Treaty of Washington of March 28, 1836 (7 Stat. 491) and the Treaty of Detroit of 1855 (11 Stat. 621);

WHEREAS in December, 2013, Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians purchased a 300 acres farm with a house, barn, shed, and garage along with household furnishings, appliances, various farm tools and equipment;

WHEREAS the farm was later renamed Ziibimijwang-- "*Place of the Flowing River*;

WHEREAS Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians purchased this property for farming to support the health and welfare of the Tribal Community;

WHEREAS Ziibimijwang, Inc. is a Tribally Chartered Corporation, incorporated by Waganakising Odawak Statute, WOS 2014-005;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians Tribal Council does hereby designate to Ziibimijwang, Inc. the use of the assets of Ziibimijwang that includes household furnishings, farm equipment, tools and other items as identified on the attached Appendix A.



BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians will retain the ownership of the assets, and prohibits the sale or disposal of the assets without Tribal Council permission.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this designation of asset use shall remain in effect until such time that it is either revoked or revised by a majority vote of Tribal Council.

CERTIFICATION

As Tribal Council Treasurer and Tribal Council Secretary, we certify that this Certified Motion was duly approved by the Tribal Council of the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians at a regular meeting of the Tribal Council held October 8, 2015 at which a quorum was present, by a vote of 7 in favor, 0 opposed, 0 abstentions, 1 absent as recorded by this certification as an official action on behalf of Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians.
