**Request for Trust Acquisition of "Wycamp Creek Access 24-05-04-35-101-003"
Parcel in Emmet County, Michigan**

WHEREAS the Secretary of the Interior is generally authorized to accept land into trust for the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians ("LTBB" or "Tribe") under the Indian Reorganization Act, 25 U.S.C. § 465, as expressly made applicable to LTBB under 25 U.S.C. § 1300k-2(a), and specifically mandated to accept transfer of lands in trust for LTBB within Emmet and Charlevoix Counties, Michigan under 25 U.S.C. § 1300k-4(a);

WHEREAS the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians possesses clear title in fee by virtue of the warranty deed dated November 3, 2016 recorded with the Emmet County Register of Deeds at Liber 1190 Page 048 to the parcel in Emmet County, Michigan described as:

Situated in the Township of Cross Village, County of Emmet, State of Michigan:

Lot 9 of Childwood, being a part of Town 38 North, Range 6 West, Cross Village Township, Emmet County, Michigan, as recorded in Liber 9 of Plats, Pages 37, 38 and 39 in the Office of the Emmet County, Michigan Register of Deeds.

which description may be subject to technical correction during the trust application process;

WHEREAS LTBB desires to transfer title of this parcel from LTBB to the United States of America in trust for the Tribe;

WHEREAS although this acquisition is mandatory, for informational purposes LTBB notes that it intends to use the parcel for environmental preservation and access to Wycamp Creek for fishing and gathering.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

1. that the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians requests that the Secretary of

the Interior accept the above described parcel in trust for the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians;

2. that the general counsel is directed to prepare the trust application and all supporting documentation, and the Executive Branch is authorized to take all necessary steps to complete the Trust acquisition, including but not limited to entering into an escrow agreement to guaranty payment of any taxes that may become due after the date of trust acceptance; and
3. that the Tribal Council Treasurer is authorized, by and on behalf of the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians, to execute a warranty deed for the parcel described above transferring title from the Tribe to the United States of America in trust for the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians.


