WHEREAS the Waganakising Odawak, known in English as Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians is a nation of citizens with inherent sovereignty and right to self-governance; and

WHEREAS the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians ("LTBB") is a federally recognized Indian Tribe under Public Law 103-324, and is a party to numerous Treaties with the United States the most recent of which being the Treaty of Washington of March 28, 1836 (7 Stat. 491) and the Treaty of Detroit of 1855 (11 Stat. 621); and

WHEREAS the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians Tribal Council is the elected Legislative body of the Tribe; and

WHEREAS the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians is a member of the Inter-Tribal Council of Michigan, Inc., a non-profit corporation duly organized under a State Charter filed April 16, 1968; and

WHEREAS the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians recognizes the importance of the assistance provided through the Low Income Housing Energy Assistance Program; and

WHEREAS the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians is eligible for the Low Income Housing Energy Assistance Program and desires to continue to participate in the program through the Inter-Tribal Council of Michigan, Inc.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians Tribal Council authorizes the Inter-Tribal Council of Michigan, Inc. to act on its behalf in contracting with the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services, Office of Community Services for the purpose of administering a Low Income Housing Energy Assistance Program for fiscal year 2018.
