WHEREAS the Waganakising Odawak, known in English as Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians is a nation of citizens with inherent sovereignty and right to self-governance; and

WHEREAS the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians ("LTBB") is a federally recognized Indian Tribe under Public Law 103-324, and is a party to numerous Treaties with the United States the most recent of which being the Treaty of Washington of March 28, 1836 (7 Stat. 491) and the Treaty of Detroit of 1855 (11 Stat. 621); and

WHEREAS the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians Tribal Council is the elected Legislative body of the Tribe; and

WHEREAS the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians is a member of the Inter-Tribal Council of Michigan, Inc., a non-profit corporation duly organized under a State Charter filed April 16, 1968; and

WHEREAS the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians recognizes the importance of the services provided through the Community Services Block Grant funds to Indian communities and vital programs; and

WHEREAS the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians Tribal Council has determined the American Indian population within the State of Michigan would be best served with the Community Services Block Grant funding applied for and distributed through the Inter-Tribal Council of Michigan, Inc.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council of the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians authorizes the Inter-Tribal Council of Michigan, Inc. to apply for the Community Services Block Grant Fund from the Office of Community Services, United States Department of Health and Human Services for the fiscal year 2018.

BE IT ALSO RESOLVED that the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians will provide the indirect costs through Program Support funds, if these costs are not allowed by the funder.

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the LTBB Tribal Chair, Vice Chair, Direct Services Administrator, or another designee from the Tribal Chair is authorized to execute any documents necessary to apply for, receive, and administer funds under the grant.


