FY 2018 Food Distribution Program on Indian Reservations (FDPIR)

WHEREAS the Waganakising Odawak, known in English as Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians is a nation of citizens with inherent sovereignty and right to self-governance and;

WHEREAS the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians ("LTBB") is a federally recognized Indian Tribe under Public Law 103-324, and is a party to numerous Treaties with the United States the most recent of which being the Treaty of Washington of March 28, 1836 (7 Stat. 491) and the Treaty of Detroit of 1855 (11 Stat. 621);

WHEREAS the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians Tribal Council is the elected legislative body of the Tribe;

WHEREAS the Tribe supports programs that help low-income households maintain a nutritionally balanced diet;

WHEREAS the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians has operated and desires to continue to operate a program that provides commodity food to low-income households, including the elderly, living on Indian reservations, and to Native American families residing in designated areas near reservations;

WHEREAS the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians recognizes the importance of the assistance provided through the USDA Food Distribution Program on Indian Reservations Program for those meeting the eligibility requirements within the Tribal community.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council of the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians authorizes and supports the Plan of Operation and budget request to the United States Department of Agriculture, Food and Nutrition Service for Fiscal Year 2018 Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians Food Distribution Program on Indian Reservations.

BE IT ALSO RESOLVED that the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians will provide the required 25% matching contribution through FY 2017 and FY 2018 program support.

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the LTBB Tribal Chair, Vice Chair, Direct Services Administrator, or another designee from the Tribal Chair is authorized to execute any documents necessary to apply for, receive, and administer funds under the grant.
