Contract Request to the United States Department of the Interior,  
Bureau of Indian Affairs,  
Circle of Flight Project FY 2017 Contract Proposal

- WHEREAS** the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians ("LTBB" or "Tribe") is a Federally recognized Indian Tribe reaffirmed by the United States Congress on September 21, 1994 in Public Law 103-324, as amended, which exercises sovereign governmental authority over the people, land, and water within its jurisdiction and administers a wide range of governmental programs;
- WHEREAS** the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians Tribal Council is the elected legislative body of the Tribe;
- WHEREAS** the Tribe has established a Natural Resources Department (NRD) and a Natural Resources Commission (NRC) whose purpose is to provide oversight and regulation of utilization of natural resources within the LTBB's jurisdiction and to provide community input in development and fulfillment of project objectives at regularly scheduled meetings of the Natural Resource Commission;
- WHEREAS** the Natural Resource Department mission statement is to *"wisely utilize our natural resources in order to promote, honor and respect our traditional, spiritual and physical relationship with the land and waters. We will implement management strategies that protect our resources on, above, below and within the land and waters for the future benefit of our Tribe;"*
- WHEREAS** ~~the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians is committed to the establishment and operation of a fish hatchery that will offer long term cultural and economic benefit to the LTBB Tribal community;~~ **TUK**
- WHEREAS** the U. S. Department of the Interior, Bureau of Indian Affairs announced FY 2017 funding availability for Circle of Flight projects that provide for a tribal and inter-tribal strategy for cooperation to preserve and enhance wetland ecosystems and associated habitats that benefit waterfowl, non-game, and threatened and endangered species.
- WHEREAS** the Tribe applied for Circle of Flight project funds under Motion 121516-10 to support a Circle of Flight project.

**WHEREAS** the BIA has informed the Tribe that the Circle of Flight project have been selected for funding.

**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Tribal Council of the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians authorizes and supports the submittal of a contract proposal to the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Indian Affairs, for the FY 2017 Circle of Flight project with the intent to receive funds under PL 93-638 contracting.

**FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the LTBB Tribal Chair, Vice Chair, Direct Services Administrator, or another designee from the Tribal Chair is authorized to execute any documents necessary to apply for, receive, and administer funds under the grant.
