Request for Funding from the University of North Dakota School of Medicine and Health
Sciences Center for Rural Health
Native Elder Abuse Innovation 2018

WHEREAS the Waganakising Odawak, known in English as Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians is a nation of citizens with inherent sovereignty and right to self-governance;

WHEREAS the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians ("LTBB") is a federally recognized Indian Tribe under Public Law 103-324, and is a party to numerous Treaties with the United States the most recent of which being the Treaty of Washington of March 28, 1836 (7 Stat. 491) and the Treaty of Detroit of 1855 (11 Stat. 621);

WHEREAS the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians Tribal Council is the elected Legislative body of the Tribe;

WHEREAS the Tribe places a high priority on the well-being of the LTBB Tribal Elders;

WHEREAS the University of North Dakota School of Medicine and Health Sciences Center for Rural Health has received funds from the United States Department of Health and Human Services, Administration for Community Living (ACL) National Indigenous Elder Justice Initiative Innovation Project and has announced funding availability under the 2018 Native Elder Abuse Innovation Awards to address the issues of elder abuse among American Indian, Alaska Native, and Native Hawaiians.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council of the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians authorizes and supports this grant application to the University of North Dakota School of Medicine and Health Sciences Center for Rural Health for a 12-month Native Elder Abuse Innovation project.

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the LTBB Tribal Chair, Vice Chair, Direct Services Administrator, or another designee from the Tribal Chair is authorized to execute any documents necessary to apply for, receive, and administer funds under the grant.
