Special Injury Prevention Project FY 2018

WHEREAS the Waganakising Odawak, known in English as Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians is a nation of citizens with inherent sovereignty and right to self-governance and;

WHEREAS the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians ("LTBB") is a federally recognized Indian Tribe under Public Law 103-324, and is a party to numerous Treaties with the United States the most recent of which being the Treaty of Washington of March 28, 1836 (7 Stat. 491) and the Treaty of Detroit of 1855 (11 Stat. 621);

WHEREAS the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians Tribal Council is the elected legislative body of the Tribe;

WHEREAS the Tribe places a high priority on the well-being of the LTBB Tribal Elders;

WHEREAS the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services, Bemidji Area Indian Health Services Division of Environmental Services has announced FY 2018 Special Injury Prevention Projects funding available to tribes to develop capacity to implement public health strategies to reduce injury risks and the incidence of injury in their communities.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council of the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians authorizes and supports this request for funding from the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services, Bemidji Area Indian Health Services, Division of Environmental Services for Special Injury Prevention funds for a 12-month elder fall prevention project.

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the LTBB Tribal Chair, Vice Chair, Direct Services Administrator, or another designee from the Tribal Chair is authorized to execute any documents necessary to apply for, receive, and administer funds under the grant.
