Request for Funding from the U.S. Department of Justice  
Adult Drug Court Discretionary Grant Program FY 2018  
White Feather Adult Drug Court Enhancements

- WHEREAS** the Waganakising Odawak, known in English as Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians is a nation of citizens with inherent sovereignty and right to self-governance;
- WHEREAS** the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians ("LTBB") is a federally recognized Indian Tribe under Public Law 103-324, and is a party to numerous Treaties with the United States the most recent of which being the Treaty of Washington of March 28, 1836 (7 Stat. 491) and the Treaty of Detroit of 1855 (11 Stat. 621);
- WHEREAS** the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians Tribal Council is the elected Legislative body of the Tribe;
- WHEREAS** the Tribal Government includes a justice system consisting of the Tribal Court as one of the three branches of Tribal Government; and
- WHEREAS** the mission of the Tribal Court is to implement the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians judicial system, consistent with self-determination and the sovereign powers of the Tribe, by building on the community values of respect, culture and spirituality, that allows for unity, fairness and due process in resolving issues, conflicts and disputes within the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians' jurisdiction; and
- WHEREAS** the U.S. Department of Justice has announced funding availability for the Adult Drug Court Discretionary Grant Program that support activities designed to develop and implement drug courts that effectively integrate evidence-based substance abuse treatment, mandatory drug testing, sanctions and incentives, and transitional services in a judicially supervised court setting with jurisdiction over substance-abusing offenders.

**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Tribal Council of the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians authorizes and supports this grant application to the U.S. Department of Justice for the FY 2018 Adult Drug Court Discretionary Grant Program for a 48-month grant to enhance the White Feather Adult Drug Court.

**BE IT ALSO RESOLVED** that the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians will provide the required 25% matching contribution from drug court team staff time and related line items from their General Fund budget.

**FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the LTBB Tribal Chair, Vice Chair, Direct Services Administrator, or another designee from the Tribal Chair is authorized to execute any documents necessary to apply for, receive, and administer funds under the grant.
