Request for Funding from the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services
Indian Health Service – Sanitation Program
Well & Septic Systems Contract Be-17-K01 Modification #01 Funding Increase

WHEREAS the Waganakising Odawak, known in English as Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians is a nation of citizens with inherent sovereignty and right to self-governance;

WHEREAS the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians (“LTBB”) is a federally recognized Indian Tribe under Public Law 103-324, and is a party to numerous Treaties with the United States the most recent of which being the Treaty of Washington of March 28, 1836 (7 Stat. 491) and the Treaty of Detroit of 1855 (11 Stat. 621);

WHEREAS the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians Tribal Council is the elected Legislative body of the Tribe;

WHEREAS the tribe and its members are eligible for all services and benefits by the Federal Government to Indians;

WHEREAS the Indian Health Service provides sanitation facilities to the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians on a yearly basis by contracting with the tribe for the installation of sanitation facilities such as wells, septic mound systems, community sewer connection, community water connection, etc;

WHEREAS the tribe does not have the financial means or the equipment to install these facilities;

WHEREAS the Contract Number BE-17-K01 has been modified by the Indian Health Services for a funding increase of \$100,000.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council of the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians supports and authorizes the acceptance of an increase in funds in the amount of \$100,000 from the Indian Health Services for the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians contract number BE-17-K01.

BE IT ALSO RESOLVED that the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians will provide any associated indirect over 5% via the Program Support budget.

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the LTBB Tribal Chair, Vice Chair, Direct Services Administrator, or another designee from the Tribal Chair is authorized to execute any documents necessary to apply for, receive, and administer funds under the grant.
