FY 2018 Tribal Victim Services Set-Aside Program

**WHEREAS** the Waganakising Odawak, known in English as Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians is a nation of citizens with inherent sovereignty and right to self-governance;

**WHEREAS** the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians (“LTBB”) is a federally recognized Indian Tribe under Public Law 103-324, and is a party to numerous Treaties with the United States the most recent of which being the Treaty of Washington of March 28, 1836 (7 Stat. 491) and the Treaty of Detroit of 1855 (11 Stat. 621); and

**WHEREAS** the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians Tribal Council is the elected Legislative body of the Tribe; and

**WHEREAS** the Tribe currently operates a Victim Support Services Program through its Department of Human Services to provide assistance to victims of domestic violence-related crimes; and

**WHEREAS** the Tribe seeks to enhance the Victim Support Services to address the specific needs of victims of crime; and

**WHEREAS** the United States Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs, Office for Victims of Crime has announced funding availability under the Fiscal Year 2018 Tribal Victim Services Set-Aside Program that supports Indian tribes efforts to improve services for victims of crime.

**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Tribal Council of the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians authorizes and supports this grant application to the U.S. United States Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs, Office for Victims of Crime for a 36-month grant to support a Tribal Victim Services Program.

**FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the LTBB Tribal Chair, Vice Chair, Direct Services Administrator, or another designee from the Tribal Chair is authorized to execute any documents necessary to apply for, receive, and administer funds under the grant.
