Acceptance of Funding from the United States Department of Justice,
Office on Violence Against Women (OVW),
Transitional Housing Assistance Grants for Victims of Sexual Assault, Domestic Violence,
Dating Violence, and Stalking FY 2018 48-Month Project

WHEREAS the Waganakising Odawak, known in English as Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians is a nation of citizens with inherent sovereignty and right to self-governance;

WHEREAS the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians (“LTBB”) is a federally recognized Indian Tribe under Public Law 103-324, and is a party to numerous Treaties with the United States the most recent of which being the Treaty of Washington of March 28, 1836 (7 Stat. 491) and the Treaty of Detroit of 1855 (11 Stat. 621);

WHEREAS the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians Tribal Council is the elected Legislative body of the Tribe;

WHEREAS the Tribe currently operates a Victim Support Services Program through its Department of Human Services to provide assistance to victims of domestic violence-related crimes;

WHEREAS the Tribe seeks to enhance the Victim Support Services Program to address the transitional housing needs of victims of domestic violence, sexual assault, dating violence or stalking;

WHEREAS the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians applied for funding under the United States Department of Justice, Office on Violence Against Women, Fiscal Year 2018 Transitional Housing Assistance Grants for 36- Month \$350,000 Transitional Housing Project;

WHEREAS the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians has been approved for a 48-month, \$515,243 Transitional Housing Project.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council of the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians authorizes and supports the acceptance of the 48-month U.S. Department of Justice, Office on Violence Against Women, Transitional Housing for Victims Program Award.

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the LTBB Tribal Chair, Vice Chair, Direct Services Administrator, or another designee from the Tribal Chair is authorized to execute any documents necessary to apply for, receive, and administer funds under the grant.


