Request for Funding from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development
Indian Housing Block Grant – Competitive Grants FY 2019

WHEREAS the Waganakising Odawak, known in English as Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians is a nation of citizens with inherent sovereignty and right to self-governance;

WHEREAS the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians (“LTBB”) is a federally recognized Indian Tribe under Public Law 103-324, and is a party to numerous Treaties with the United States the most recent of which being the Treaty of Washington of March 28, 1836 (7 Stat. 491) and the Treaty of Detroit of 1855 (11 Stat. 621);

WHEREAS the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians Tribal Council is the elected Legislative body of the Tribe;

WHEREAS the Tribal Council recognizes the importance of operating programs addressing housing for Tribal citizens;

WHEREAS the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians submits an annual housing that reflects the LTBB Housing Program status and plans for affordable housing activities for the subsequent fiscal year;

WHEREAS the LTBB community faces a housing shortage, including the number of units available for low-income Tribal families.

WHEREAS U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) is providing competitive funding to new construction projects, rehabilitation projects, and related necessary infrastructure projects to assist in providing strong and viable affordable housing projects in Indian Country.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council of the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians authorizes and supports an application for funding from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development for a 60-month project to develop and construct new housing to reduce the housing shortage in the LTBB community.

BE IT FUTHER RESOLVED that the Odawa Property Managers supports this application and Tribal Council will designate the buildable vacant property found on Murray Road (as indicated on attached site plan) to the LTBB Executive Branch upon grant award.

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the LTBB Tribal Chair, Vice Chair, Executive Directors, or another designee from the Tribal Chair is authorized to execute any documents necessary to apply for, receive, and administer funds under the grant.
