
- WHEREAS** the Waganakising Odawak Nation, known as the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians, and its citizens are vested with inherent sovereignty and right to self-governance;
- WHEREAS** the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians (“LTBB” or “Tribe”) is a federally recognized Indian Tribe under Public Law 103-324, and is a party to numerous Treaties with the United States the most recent of which being the Treaty of Washington of March 28, 1836 (7 Stat. 491) and the Treaty of Detroit of 1855 (11 Stat. 621);
- WHEREAS** the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians Tribal Council is the elected legislative body of the Tribe;
- WHEREAS** the Tribe places a high priority on the health and welfare of all Tribal members;
- WHEREAS** promotion of the health of Tribal members and members of other tribes eligible for services provided by the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians under laws and regulations governing recipients of Indian Health Services funding is a central mission of the Tribe;
- WHEREAS** the Tribal Health Department receives an Indian Health Service budget annually that supports the delivery of health services to Indians, including the administrative activities at the Area and Headquarter levels, that are supporting of, but not included as part of, the service delivery programs already contracted under the Indian Health Services 638 Contract;
- WHEREAS** the Contract Number 239-19-0001 has been modified by the Indian Health Services for a funding increase in the amount of \$33,781 for M&I and Equipment increases.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council of the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians supports and authorizes the acceptance of funds in the amount of \$33,781 from the Indian Health Service for the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians annual funding contract number 239-19-0001;
