Designation and Assignment of Murray Road, Charlevoix, Michigan Land Parcel

WHEREAS the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians (LTBB) is a federally recognized Indian Tribe reaffirmed by the United States Congress on September 21, 1994 in Public Law 103-324, as amended, which exercises sovereign governmental authority over the people, land, and water within its jurisdiction;

WHEREAS in 2000, Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians purchased vacant land in the Township of Hayes, County of Charlevoix, State of Michigan, Michigan Meridian, containing 80 acres, more or less:

The East $\frac{1}{2}$ of the Southeast Quarter of Section 11, Town 34 North, Range 7 West.

WHEREAS there is vacant land on the northern portion of the property that is suitable for agriculture as identified in the site map dated December 4, 2019, as noted as the "North Agricultural Areas";

WHEREAS the Executive would like to utilize the property for the planning of crops and has submitted site plan for the Cemetery Road Property dated December 4, 2019;

WHEREAS the Executive would like to utilize the property for the hunting, with the hunting season beginning on November 1st through Sunday of the first full weekend in January has submitted site plan for the Cemetery Road Property dated December 4, 2019;

WHEREAS in accordance with the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians Tribal Constitution, Tribal Council approves land uses, zoning and leases;
