Request for Funding from State Court Administrative Office
Swift and Sure Sanctions Probation Program (SSSPP) FY 2021

WHEREAS the Waganakising Odawak, known in English as Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians is a nation of citizens with inherent sovereignty and right to self-governance;

WHEREAS the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians ("LTBB") is a federally recognized Indian Tribe under Public Law 103-324, and is a party to numerous Treaties with the United States the most recent of which being the Treaty of Washington of March 28, 1836 (7 Stat. 491) and the Treaty of Detroit of 1855 (11 Stat. 621);

WHEREAS the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians Tribal Council is the elected Legislative body of the Tribe;

WHEREAS the mission of the Tribal Court is to implement the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians judicial system, consistent with self-determination and the sovereign powers of the Tribe, by building on the community values of respect, culture and spirituality, that allows for unity, fairness and due process in resolving issues, conflicts and disputes within the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians' jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS the Michigan Supreme Court, State Court Administrative Office has reimbursement funding available under the Swift and Sure Sanctions Probation Program (SSSPP) to improve probationer success by promptly imposing graduated sanctions for probation violations. The program targets high-risk felony offenders with a history of probation violations failures.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council of the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians authorizes and supports this grant application to the State Court Administrative Office for a 12-month project to improve probationer successes

BE IT ALSO RESOLVED that the Little Traverse Bay Bands of Odawa Indians will provide the associated indirect costs through Tribal Court's General Fund.

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the LTBB Tribal Chair, Vice Chair, Executive Directors, Court Administrator, or another designee from the Tribal Chair is authorized to execute any documents necessary to apply for, receive, and administer funds under the grant.
