


Tribal Nations Conference 2015

November 4-6, 2015

The goal of this meeting is for President Obama and his staff to create nation-to-nation discussions on issues affecting Indian Country. We heard addresses from different members of Obama's staff and were allowed to meet with some of them. One of the issues that I brought up was our Tribe's concern for the Line 5 oil pipeline running through the Straits of Mackinac. Obama gave a short address to the Tribal Nations in attendance, which centered around the importance of Native youth. After his address, he invited some youth to come up on stage with him for a Q&A, where the youth asked Obama questions and he also asked them questions. I was close to shaking the President's hand but ultimately missed out.
