Bea law, Tribal Councilor Report

Meeting Called to order 11:15 A.M.

- Financial report CORA has \$17,250. On hand LTBB dues just received not included in balance. GTB and LRB still due.
- Request of \$2,400 to replace flooring and painting that needs done on the CORA building. \$1,500.00 was approved by way of phone poll for the training required by the Coast Guard for dock inspectors. Three persons were qualified. New regulation is required for fisher boats and fisher man by the Coast Guard.
- Michigan Tribes have been denied Circle of Life Funding by the BIA. Bay Mills legal Kandy Tierney, will draft a letter to be reviewed before sent to BIA. Tribes disagree with the BIA in this matter.
- Chairman, Chief of Police R. Marchand Law Enforcement Committee reported he has written to the state noting all person who are Certified with the US government. Safety regulation each tribe has usually shared.
- Mike Ripley with ITFAP reported there will be no stocking of Lake Trout after 2020 in Lake Superior and Ontario as not to impede the wild fish. Sea lamprey is at good levels. Tip of the Mitt have asked if CORA would like to sign on to their letter to Enbridge regarding the Oil Pipelines.
- Walleye Stipulation Discussion with the State after discussion Bay Mills legal Kandy Tierney will compose a letter for CORA.
- Elks Permits still in discussion with State.
- Wolf Dispute with the State and LBR Jimmy Mitchell informed all of a meeting on this subject in Detroit July 10, 2014 encourages all to attend and let others know of the meeting to attend.
- Daugherty Johnson informed all of that fines/penalties will be imposed for overfishing Lake Trout. There were reports of over fishing for 2013.
- Chairman Fred Kegioma asked about the abandoned Gill Nets. LRB Jiminy Mitchell responded that as far as he knows they have been pulled.
