**Re: Enbridge Presentation / St Ignace**

On Wednesday, February 5<sup>th</sup>, 2014 I traveled from my home in Harbor Springs, MI to the Little Bear Ice Arena in St Ignace, MI to listen to the Presentation given by Enbridge re: Line 5 that operates in the Great Lakes, specifically through the Straits of Mackinac.

Prior to providing any information it was explained in very plain terms that questions would not be answered about the Kalamazoo River spill nor would outbursts of any kind be tolerated. Index cards were passed around the room for people to write their questions for the Enbridge officials. However the answering of questions was at the speaker's discretion, similar questions were grouped together and not all questions were addressed. The information that was provided to the large number of people gathered was controlled & limited.

Enbridge reports that Line 5 is running light crude only below the Straits of Mackinac, no plan to pump Tar Sands through this line.

Safety measures reported: 1)Cathodic protection of pipe lines. 2)EFRD's – Emergency Flow Restriction Devices. 3)ILI = In Line Inspection for corrosion of both the interior as well as the exterior, axial cracks, dents, buckles & gouges.

OSRO = Oil Spill Removal Organizations

PREP = Preparedness for Response Exercise Program
